  - Project: Holy Cross Catholic Church
  - Location: New York, New York
    - Client: DCAK-MSA Architecture
  - Synopsis: Holy Cross, founded in 1852, has been serving at "The Crossroads of the World" and "Hell's Kitchen" for all these years and is perhaps one of the most well-known churches in New York. A complete restoration of the church was completed in September of 2010.
- Challenges: Historic church with limited access and demanding lighting program.
  - Solution: A comprehensive 3D model allowed for the thorough analysis of lighting alternatives and the design of custom, high-output pendant lanterns that met demanding illumination requirements within a limited footprint.
  - Results: 2010 AIA Design Honor Award
